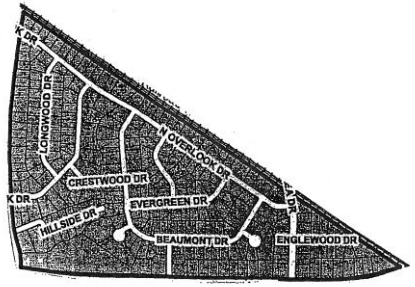

Traffic Calming Update

A traffic calming survey was conducted at our request by the City of Greenville. 85% of vehicles traveling on North Overlook Drive averaged 9 miles over the speed limit. However, the neighborhood did not qualify for traffic calming interventions (ex. Speed bumps). The data were forwarded to the Greenville Police Department with a request for increased enforcement of the speed limit. The data do suggest that we should all pay very close attention to the neighborhood speed limit.
